School Re-organisation Proposal – Establishment of a Learning Resource Base at Caerleon Lodge Hill Primary School

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

To move to formal consultation on a school re-organisation proposal "to establish a generic 10-place Learning Resource Base class for pupils aged between 4 years and 11 years with additional learning needs at Caerleon Lodge Hill Primary School with effect from April 2019"

This report makes reference to the replacement school build project that is currently underway at Caerleon Lodge Hill Primary School as part of the 21st Century Schools programme. The new building will benefit from an additional classroom space which it is proposed is used to create a generic 10-place Learning Resource Base to accommodate pupils with additional learning needs for whom a full-time mainstream placement is not deemed suitable.

This proposal supports the increasing demand for specialist education provision across the city of Newport, a need which has grown significantly over the past 5-10 years. There is currently no such primary Learning Resource Base provision within the Caerleon or St Julian's cluster areas. This proposal will therefore benefit pupils living locally but is not exclusive to those living within this cluster area. It can be accessed by pupils across the city to support specific education needs in an appropriate and secure environment.

The report recommends moving to a period of formal consultation on this proposal in accordance with the requirements of the statutory School Organisation Code.
