Statutory Notice – School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013

Notice is given in accordance with section 44 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Newport City Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to alter Maes Ebbw School, Maesglas Road, Newport, NP20 3DG so that the total capacity of the school for pupils aged between 3 years and 19 years is increased from 100 to 150. As at October 2017, there were 142 pupils on roll at the school including 127 on the main site.

It is proposed to implement this proposal from 1st April 2019.

This school is an English-medium community special school maintained by Newport City Council for pupils whose additional learning needs cannot otherwise be met within either mainstream or Learning Resource Base provisions. Admission to the school is based on an assessment of need as determined by the Chief Education Officer.

The Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. Maes Ebbw School serves the whole of the City and supports the provision of education for children whose statement of Special Educational Needs includes a requirement for specialist provision. The school offers a well-resourced environment but is over-subscribed. This proposal will see the creation of seven additional classrooms and a sensory garden along with the provision of associated ancillary services.

The Council provides free transport to eligible pupils where appropriate to individual needs. This provision will not be affected by this proposal.

Objection Period

Within a period of 28 days after the date of the publication of these proposals, that is to say by 12th February 2018, any persons may object in writing or by email to the proposals. Rhoddir rhybudd yn unol ag adran 44 Deddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 a'r Cod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion bod Cyngor Dinas Casnewydd, wedi ymgynghori yn ôl y gofynion, yn cynnig newid Ysgol Maes Ebbw, Maesglas Road, Casnewydd, NP20 3DG fel y cynyddir nifer y lleoedd ynddi ar gyfer plant o oedran ysgol rhwng 3 a 19 oed, o 100 i 150. Ym mis Hydref 2017, roedd 142 o ddisgyblion wedi'u cofrestru yn yr ysgol gan gynnwys 127 ar y prif safle.

Y bwriad yw gweithredu'r cynnig o 1 Ebrill 2019 ymlaen.

Mae'r ysgol yn un arbennig gymunedol cyfrwng Saesneg a gynhelir gan Gyngor Dinas Casnewydd ar gyfer disgyblion nad oes modd bodloni eu hanghenion dysgu ychwanegol naill ai o fewn darpariaeth brif ffrwd neu ddarpariaeth Canolfan Adnoddau Dysgu. Mae derbyniadau i'r ysgol yn seiliedig ar asesiad o angen fel y'i pennir gan y Prif Swyddog Addysg.

Cynhaliodd yr Awdurdod gyfnod ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn. Mae'r ysgol yn cynnig amgylchedd â digon o adnoddau, ond mae gormod o ddisgyblion yn mynychu. Bydd y cynnig hwn yn creu saith ystafell ddosbarth ychwanegol a gardd synhwyraidd ynghyd â darparu gwasanaethau ategol cysylltiedig.

Mae'r Cyngor yn darparu trafniadaeth am ddim i ddisgyblion cymwys lle bo'n briodol ar gyfer anghenion unigol. Ni fydd y cynnig hwn yn effeithio ar y ddarpariaeth hon.
