

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION

Election for the Newport East Constituency

1. An election is to be held for a member to serve in the House of Commons for the Newport East Parliamentary Constituency.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Deputy Acting Returning Officer at Room 527a, Civic Centre, Newport, between the hours of 10-00am and 4-00pm on any working day (Monday to Friday) after the date of this notice, but not later than **4-00 pm on Thursday, 11th May, 2017**. Candidate's deposits will be accepted by cash or bankers draft drawn against a High Street Bank.
3. Nomination papers may be obtained at the place and times mentioned above. The Acting Returning Officer will, at the request of any elector, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
4. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **THURSDAY, 8th June, 2017**.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **midnight on Monday 22nd May, 2017**.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below, by **5 p.m. on Tuesday 23rd May, 2017**.
7. Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Office below, by **5pm on Wednesday, 31st May, 2017**.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address below by **5 p.m. on 8th June, 2017**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5pm on Wednesday, 31st May, 2017**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5pm on Wednesday, 31st May, 2017**.
