Sport and Leisure must maximise service efficiency. | A review of customer Squash participation has been undertaken to determine when customers are using and not utilising services. The outcome is that the operation of the NISV Squash Court Complex is not financially viable with only 16% of utilisation and current closure of 1 Court due to structural failure. Consultation with Head of Service and key Sport and Leisure Managers to review options has been undertaken as three proposals including Newport Centre Gym refurbishment, Underwood Leisure Centre closure and NISV Squash Court Complex proposals. This will result in the closure of all Newport City Council operated Squash Courts. |
