

The loss of a child is an unbearable situation that no parent ever imagines they will have to face. We recognise that dealing with financial practicalities while coping with the emotions surrounding loss are difficult in any circumstance.

In Wales, local authorities do not charge any fees related to burial and cremation for children under the age of 18. In addition, families in Wales that have registered the loss of a child under the age of 18 are entitled to receive £500 as a contribution towards the funeral and other related costs.

It will be up to each family to decide how they can best spend the money. The type of costs are not restricted but could include: a coffin, shroud, casket; or other covering; a container for storing ashes; meeting the costs charged by a funeral provider (including funeral director fees); funeral vehicles; floral tributes; death notifications; removal of medical devices; fees for medical certificates and death registration certificates; memorials, plaques; and masonry (headstones). The payment will be made to the person registering the loss unless an alternative name is provided.

The local authority Registrar office will discuss this with families when registering the loss and can provide further information.

You may also be entitled to apply for the Department for Work and Pension's funeral expenses payment (<https://www.gov.uk/funeral-payments/how-to-claim>) if you are in receipt of certain benefits or tax credits.
