There are a range of specialist support services operating across Gwent, in addition to NHS provided care, ensuring that any health need is not a barrier to access.</i></p>	
<p>Drug and Alcohol support and recovery, Rapid prescribing and Assertive Outreach- Gwent Drug and Alcohol Service (GDAS) and Gwent Specialist Substance Misuse Service (GSSMS) are the key providers in Newport.</p>	<p>The following services refer in to GDAS/GSSMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Wallich -Eden Gate -Pobl -Feed Newport <p>The Rough Sleeper Co-ordinator and GDAS agree referrals for rapid prescribing services.</p>
<p>Sexual Health services</p>	<p>The Sexual Exploitation Advocacy Support Service (SEASS) operates within Newport via drop in, outreach and a helpline.</p> <p>Access via the Housing Support Grant Team and direct to Cyfannol Womens Aid.</p>
