

One Newport Public Services Board (PSB) - Summary of Business: 13 March 2018

Local Well-being Plan Consultation Responses

There were 68 responses to the public consultation on the Well-being Plan and the feedback was largely positive. The Board agreed changes to the Well-being Plan in the light of responses received.

The next step is for the plan to be approved by the four statutory members of the board: Newport City Council, Aneurin Bevan University Health Board, Natural Resources Wales and South Wales Fire and Rescue Service. The plan will be submitted to the PSB for final approval on 1st May.

Local Well-being Plan: Delivery and Performance Framework

The Board agreed a framework for monitoring delivery and performance for the Well-being Plan.

The Plan contains five cross cutting interventions (the Newport Offer; Strong Resilient Communities; Right Skills; Green and Safe Spaces; Sustainable Travel), which will each be led by a PSB member. The leads will be agreed by the PSB at its meeting in May.

Membership – Newport Live

The Board has agreed to invite Newport Live to join the PSB, representing the cultural sector.

Youth Council Representation

The Board considered a report reviewing representation by Newport Youth Council (NYC) on the PSB. The purpose of NYC representation is to ensure PSB decision making is effectively informed by the views of young people.

The Chair, Councillor Wilcox, will be the link with NYC to support participation in PSB meetings, champion the views of young people and facilitate the Board's youth engagement.

Scrutiny of the PSB

The work of the PSB is scrutinised by Newport City Council's Performance Scrutiny Committee – Partnerships.

The latest letter from the Scrutiny Committee Chair, Councillor Rahman, commented on performance against the Single Integrated Plan and noted that there was clear evidence of cross partnership working which was very positive for Newport residents.

Single Integrated Plan 2017-18 progress

The lead officers for the three themes in the Single Integrated Plan reported on Q3 performance. The themes are Economy & Skills, Health & Wellbeing, and Safe & Cohesive Communities. Performance dashboards are available on <u>One Newport website.</u>

Support for Public Services Boards 2018-19

Welsh Government is providing regional funding for Public Services Boards for 2018-19.

Funding bids are being prepared for joint work by the PSBs in Gwent. Newport PSB is leading on developing the bids.
