<p>SRC Board continues to focus short term attention on a place based approach in the East of Newport. We are working with the local community in Ringland to develop social capital with a view to improving well-being and quality of life. Following a workshop earlier this year, progress is being made in developing a delivery plan aligned with the integrated wellbeing networks programme.</p> <p>The Mutual Gain Project to increase social capital and community resilience to serious and organised crime in Ringland is complete and has been evaluated. The outcome of the evaluation was positive and legacy work is being planned. The unsuccessful bids under the Participatory Budgeting scheme are now being reviewed with a view to supporting additional projects that would benefit the local community. In addition, a legacy working group has met to discuss continuation of projects relating to the Mutual Gain work.</p> <p>Ringland Community Campus includes 3 strands: health and well-being centre, Neighbourhood Hub & Newport City Homes (NCH) masterplan regeneration programme. NCH have undertaken community consultation events on their proposed Ringland regeneration masterplan ahead of a planning application early next year.</p> <p>Volunteering programme – a participatory budgeting fund is in place to fund community projects and boost volunteering.
