Draft Vision, Issues and Objectives Consultation

Consultation: 31 January 2022 – 25 March 2022

The RLDP will guide the development of the city over the next 15 years, this report sets out what the Council believes are the key issues, challenges and opportunities facing Newport and provides a Draft Vision and Objectives for the RLDP.

- 17 March 2022 - 6.30 pm Pill Millennium Centre, Courtybella Terrace, Newport, NP20 2GH

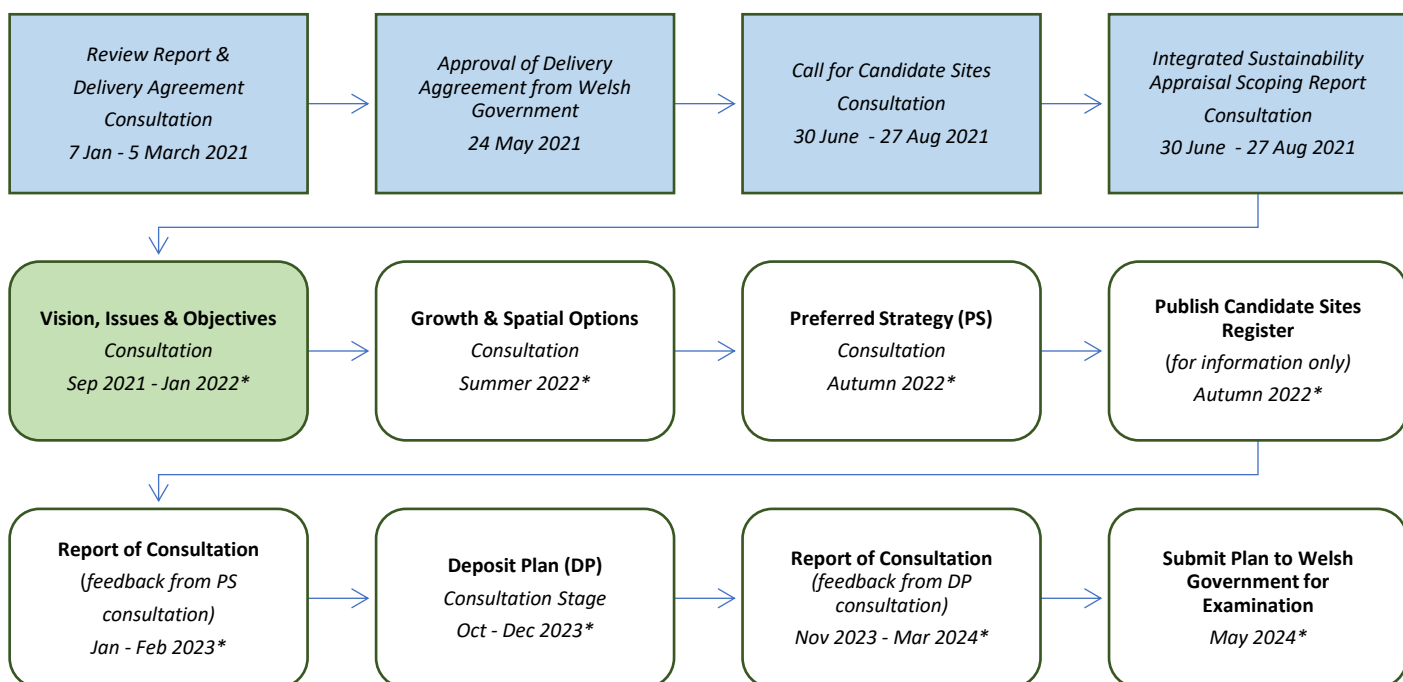

Growth and Spatial Options – Summer 2022
