New Primary Reorganisation Proposal

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This report detailed moving to Formal Consultation to establish a new Primary School which was to be situated on the Alcan housing development and currently had the working title of "Jubilee Park" Primary School. Once established, the Temporary Governing Body can determine the name of the school.

In order to establish a new Primary school, a Formal Consultation with all stakeholders would be required.

It was proposed that the establishment of this school which would include a nursery took effect from September 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter.

This proposal was for a "growing school" on a growing development, the report provided some detail and assurance that the full Formal Consultation pack would enable all consultees and stakeholders to be fully appraised of the proposed design for the school.

Decision

To move to Formal Consultation on the reorganisation proposal "to establish a new Primary School for ages three to 11 years with effect from September 2017".

New Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) School – Move to Statutory Notice

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

Formal consultation has been carried out on the proposal “to establish a new special school in Newport to accommodate pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) on the current infant site of Gaer Primary School, with effect from April 2017” during the period 11 April 2016 and 22 May 2016. A “Consultation Report” which described the findings in some detail had been published on the Council web site. This report referenced those findings and made a recommendation to move to the publication of a statutory notice in respect of this proposal. During that statutory notice legal objections can be set by any consultee, which would need to be considered before any final determination is taken.

Decision

To move to the publication of a statutory notice for 28 days in respect of the proposal “to establish a new special school in Newport to accommodate pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) on the current infant site of Gaer Primary School, with effect from April 2017”.
