### Statutory Notice – School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013

Notice is given in accordance with section 41 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Newport City Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to establish a new English-medium primary school to be maintained by Newport City Council at Jubilee Way, Rogerstone, Newport for boys and girls aged 3-11.

The Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A consultation report, containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees and the proposer's response and the views of Estyn is available on the Newport City Council website at [www.newport.gov.uk/schoolreorg](http://www.newport.gov.uk/schoolreorg)

The new primary school will have a published admission number of 45, and eventual capacity for 315 pupils of statutory school age. In addition there will be a nursery class with capacity for 48 part-time places, delivered over either a morning or afternoon session, and a 10 place generic Learning Resource Base to support pupils with Additional Learning Needs whose needs cannot be met solely within mainstream education.

It is proposed to implement the proposal on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 under a growing school model as follows:

- Year 1 – On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 the school will be established with a published admission number of 15 across all year groups, with provision for 15 full-time equivalent nursery pupils.
- Year 2 – From 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018, the published admission number will increase to 30 across all year groups, with provision for 24 full-time equivalent nursery pupils.
- Year 3 – From 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019, the agreed published admission number of 45 will be realised across all year groups, plus provision for 24 full time equivalent nursery pupils.

The Learning Resource Base will be fully operational from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017.

The proposed new school will be a community primary school. Newport City Council will be the admission authority for the proposed school. It is not proposed that the admission arrangements will make any provision for selection by aptitude or ability. Parents of children who are admitted for nursery education will still need to apply for a place at the school if they want their child to transfer to a Reception class.

The Council has a Home to School Transport policy and provides free transport to eligible pupils of statutory school age. This provision will not be affected by this proposal. Further information in relation to this policy is available on the Council website.

#### **Objection Period**

Within a period of 28 days after the date of the publication of these proposals, that is to say by 8 March 2017, any persons may object in writing or by email to the proposals. ### Hysbysiad Statudol – Deddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013

Hysbysir yn unol ag adran 41 o Ddeddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru)2013 a'r Cod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion fod Cyngor Dinas Casnewydd, ar ôl ymgynghori â'r cyfryw bersonau sy'n ofynnol, yn cynnig y dylid sefydlu ysgol gynradd cyfrwng Saesneg newydd i'w chynnal gan Gyngor Dinas Casnewydd yn Jubilee Way, Tŷ-du, Casnewydd ar gyfer bechgyn a merched rhwng 3 ac 11 oed.

Cynhaliodd y Cyngor gyfnod ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn. Mae adroddiad ar yr ymgynghoriad, sy'n cynnwys crynodeb o'r materion a godwyd gan ymgynghoreion ac ymateb y cynigydd a barn Estyn ar gael ar wefan Cyngor Dinas Casnewydd yn [www.newport.gov.uk/schoolreorg](http://www.newport.gov.uk/schoolreorg)

Nifer derbyn cyhoeddedig yr ysgol gynradd newydd fydd 45, a bydd lle yn y pen draw i 315 o ddisgyblion o oedran ysgol statudol. Yn ogystal, bydd dosbarth meithrin â lle i 48 o blant ar sail rhan amser, naill ai mewn sesiwn fore neu sesiwn brynhawn, a Chanolfan Adnoddau Dysgu gyffredinol i gefnogi 10 o ddisgyblion ag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol na ellir diwallu eu hanghenion drwy addysg prif ffrwd yn unig.

Cynigir gweithredu'r cynnig ar 1 Medi 2017 o dan fodel ysgol sy'n tyfu fel a ganlyn:

- Blwyddyn 1 – Ar 1 Medi 2017 caiff yr ysgol ei sefydlu gyda nifer derbyn cyhoeddedig o 15 ar draws pob grŵp blwyddyn, â darpariaeth ar gyfer 15 o ddisgyblion meithrin cyfwerth ag amser llawn.
- Blwyddyn 2 – O 1 Medi 2018, bydd y nifer derbyn cyhoeddedig yn cynyddu i 30 ar draws pob grŵp blwyddyn, gyda darpariaeth ar gyfer 24 o ddisgyblion meithrin cyfwerth ag amser llawn.
- Blwyddyn 3 - O 1 Medi 2019, caiff y nifer derbyn cyhoeddedig o 45 ei wireddu ar draws pob grŵp blwyddyn, ynghyd â darpariaeth ar gyfer 24 o ddisgyblion meithrin cyfwerth ag amser llawn.

Bydd y Ganolfan Adnoddau Dysgu yn gwbl weithredol o 1 Medi 2017.

Bydd yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig yn ysgol gynradd gymunedol. Cyngor Dinas Casnewydd fydd yr awdurdod derbyn ar gyfer yr ysgol arfaethedig. Ni chynigir y bydd y trefniadau derbyn yn gwneud unrhyw ddarpariaeth ar gyfer dethol yn ôl dawn neu allu. Bydd angen i rieni plant sy'n cael eu derbyn i addysg feithrin wneud cais am le yn yr ysgol o hyd os ydynt am i'w plentyn drosglwyddo i ddsbarth Derbyn.

Mae gan y Cyngor bolisi Cludiant o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol ac mae'n darparu trafniadaeth am ddim i ddisgyblion cymwys o oedran ysgol statudol. Ni fydd y cynnig hwn yn effeithio ar y ddarpariaeth honno. Ceir rhagor o wybodaeth mewn perthynas â'r polisi hwn ar wefan y Cyngor.
