Malpas Church in Wales Infant and Primary Schools – Move to Statutory Notice

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

A joint formal consultation was carried out on the following proposal. "The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School proposes to extend the age-range of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School from 7-11yrs to 4-11yrs with effect from 1 September 2017. To enable a new all-through 4-11yrs primary school to be established on the site from September 2017. As a consequence, Newport City Council was proposing Malpas Church in Wales Infant School be discontinued on 31 August 2017."

The Joint formal consultation process was carried out during the period 29 November 2016 to 15 January 2017 and a "Joint Consultation Report" described the findings in some detail, this has been published on the Council web site. This report references those findings and makes a recommendation to move to the Joint publication of a statutory notice in respect of this proposal. During that statutory notice period legal objections could be set by any consultee, which would need to be considered before any final determination was taken.

Decision

To move to the Joint publication of a statutory notice for 28 days in respect of the following proposal. "The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School proposed to extend the age-range of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School from 7-11yrs to 4-11yrs with effect from 1st September 2017. To enable a new all-through 4-11yrs primary school to be established on the site from September 2017. As a consequence, Malpas Church in Wales Infant School would be discontinued on 31 August 2017."
