Notice is given in accordance with sections 42 and 43 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Newport City Council (“the Council”) and the Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School (“the Governing Body”), having consulted such persons as required, proposes the following:

- The Governing Body to alter Malpas Church in Wales Junior School, Yewberry Close Newport NP20 6WJ, by changing the age range from 7-11 to 4-11.
- The Council to discontinue Malpas Church in Wales Infant School, Yewberry Close, Newport NP20 6WJ. The school is currently maintained by Newport City Council and is a voluntary controlled Church in Wales school.

The Council and the Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School undertook a period of joint consultation before deciding to publish these proposals. The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School is proposing to extend the age range of Malpas Church in Wales Junior School from 7-11 to 4-11. This will enable the establishment of a new single all-through English-medium voluntary controlled Church in Wales Primary School to accommodate children aged between 4 and 11 years from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017. The new primary school will have a published admission number of 54 and capacity for 378 pupils in total. All pupils on roll at the Infant School as at midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017 will transfer to the new Primary School when it opens on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017.

The Governing Body proposes to implement the proposal to alter Malpas Church in Wales Junior School on 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017. As a result, the Council proposes to implement the proposal to discontinue Malpas Church in Wales Infant School at midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017.

The Council has a Home to School Transport policy and provides free transport to eligible pupils of statutory school age. This provision will not be affected by this proposal. Further information in relation to this policy is available on the Council website.

#### Objection Period

Within a period of 28 days after the date of the publication of these proposals, that is to say by 27 March 2017, any persons may object in writing or by email to the proposals.

Mae Corff Llywodraethu Ysgol Iau yr Eglwys yng Nghymru, Malpas yn cynnig ymestyn ystod oedran Ysgol Iau yr Eglwys yng Nghymru, Malpas o 7-11 i 4-11. Bydd hyn yn galluogi sefydlu un Ysgol Gynradd yr Eglwys yng Nghymru cyfrwng Saesneg a reolir yn wirfoddol ar gyfer plant rhwng 4 ac 11 oed o 1 Medi 2017. Nifer derbyn cyhoeddedig yr ysgol gynradd newydd fydd 54, a bydd lle i gyfanswm o 378 o ddisgyblion.
