

**NEWPORT CITY COUNCIL**  
**Statutory Notice – School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013**

Notice is given in accordance with sections 42 and 48 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Newport City Council, having consulted such persons as required, propose to extend the age range of Marshfield Primary School, maintained by Newport City Council at Marshfield Road, Newport CF3 2UW.

The pupil age range will change from 4-11 years to 3-11 years.

It is proposed to implement the proposal on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 when up to 32 pupils will be admitted to the nursery class; 16 for the morning session and 16 for the afternoon session.

The council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A consultation report containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees, the proposer's responses and the views of Estyn is available on the Newport City Council website at [www.newport.gov.uk/schools](http://www.newport.gov.uk/schools) under *school reorganisation*.

The council has a school transport policy and provides free home to school transport for eligible statutory school age pupils. This provision will not be affected by this proposal. Further information on school transport is available on our website under *School transport*.

**Objection Period**

Within a period of 28 days after the date of the publication of these proposals, that is to say by 10 March 2016 any persons may object in writing or by e-mail to the proposals. The council will publish a summary of any such objections made (and not withdrawn in writing) within the objection period, together with their observations thereon, at the time of notification to stakeholders of the determination of the proposal.
