Duffryn Infant & Duffryn Junior Schools: Move to Statutory Notice

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

A formal consultation was carried out on the proposal to amalgamate Duffryn Infant School and Duffryn Junior School into an all-through 3 to 11 years primary school, with effect from April 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter. The consultation process was carried out during the period 5 September 2016 to 16 October 2016. The report referring to this decision described the findings in some detail, this was available on the Council web site. The report referenced those findings and made a recommendation to move to the publication of a statutory notice in respect of this proposal. During that statutory notice period legal objections could be set by any consultee, which would need to be considered before any final determination was taken.

Decision

To move to the publication of a statutory notice for 28 days in respect of the proposal to amalgamate Duffryn Infant School and Duffryn Junior School into an all-through 3 to 11 years primary school, with effect from April 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter.

Milton Infant & Milton Junior Schools: Move to Statutory Notice

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

The consultation process was carried out during the period 5th September 2016 to 16th October 2016 and a Consultation Report was published on the Council web site. During that statutory notice period legal objections could be set by any consultee, which would need to be considered before any final determination is taken.
