What do some of the words in this document mean?

<u>Joint Proposal</u> – A plan that the Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School and Newport City Council are thinking of putting into action but haven't decided upon yet.

<u>Consultation</u> – This gives people the chance to ask questions and express their views on the proposal.

<u>Published Admission Number (PAN)</u> – The number of pupils that can be admitted into each year group at a school.

<u>Drop-in Session</u> – A meeting to talk about a plan. You do not need an appointment and can come anytime during the session.

<u>Cluster Primary School</u> – Each secondary school in Newport has a number of primary schools that make up the school cluster. The schools work together to support children moving from primary school into secondary school.

<u>School Reorganisation Proposal</u> – A plan we are thinking of putting into action to make big changes to a school.

<u>Half-day placements</u> – Pupils on half-day placements will attend either a morning or an afternoon session. These normally last between two and two and a half hours.

Amalgamated – Things brought together in one place and as one organisation.

<u>Mixed Classes</u> – A class where the pupils can be from different year groups.

<u>School Forecasts</u> – These are the predicted pupil numbers for the future.



Introduction

The number of pupils joining the Reception classes at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School has been getting lower over the past 5 years. The low pupil numbers means that space within the school become available and the school would like to use this space to create a nursery class.

Low pupil numbers can cause problems for a school as this can affect the school staffing needs and leave classrooms empty. The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School want Newport City Council to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) by 9 places from 54 to 45 from September 2024. This will reduce the number of children who can join the school, but it will allow the school to make use of the available space to establish a nursery class. It would also provide stability for planning and staffing in the school.

Malpas Church in Wales Primary School is the only primary school in the Newport High School cluster that does not provide a nursery class. In the past, pupils who attended Kimberley Nursery School would often progress to Malpas Church in Wales Primary School. Kimberley Nursery School amalgamated with Fairoak Nursery School into the new Newport Nursery School on the former Fairoak Nursery School site in September 2021. This reduced the availability of nursery places in the Malpas area.

The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School want to establish a 16 place nursery class and extend the age range of the school from 4-11 to 3-11 from September 2025.

Before this change can be made, the school's Governing Body and the Local Authority have to ask the school community – parents, pupils and other interested people, what they think of the idea. This is called a formal consultation.

This formal consultation period:

- Begins on 19 June 2023
- Ends at midnight on 30 July 2023

The Consultation Process

As part of the 'School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013', before a proposal is published, first it must be subject to consultation. The consultation process is made up of a number of stages, as presented in the table below:




The Plan


The plan is to reduce the PAN by 9 places from 54 to 45 from September 2024, and then establish a 16 place nursery class, changing the age range from 4-11 to 3-11, from September 2025 at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School.

For the Governing Body to establish a 16 place (32 half-day placements) nursery base in Malpas Church in Wales Primary School, the Council (who arrange admissions into the school) need to reduce the PAN of the school.

The Council proposes to reduce the PAN of the school by 9 places from 54 to 45 from September 2024. The numbers at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School over the past 5 years having been going down, this means the amount of empty places at the school is going up. The chart below shows the amount of places in the whole school over the past 5 years against the maximum amount of pupils the school can admit:



The school forecasts show the pupil numbers will continue to decrease over the next 4 years. With the lowest number of pupils estimated in 2025/26 of 239.




The proposed nursery class will use a classroom that is available because of the lower number of pupils now attending the school.



The establishment of a new nursery class will provide the following benefits:

- © 32 new half-day nursery placements in the Malpas area;
- © Positive movement for children from nursery to reception within the same school;
- © Makes good use of available space.

Nursery places are very limited in the Malpas and surrounding areas, there are only 5 places left in school nurseries and 2 in a local private provider called Tiny Tots, located on Malpas Road.



The disadvantages of establishing a new nursery class could:

- ⊗ Places could be spread across the local area;
- © Could see local providers reduce the number of morning and afternoon sessions they offer.

What will the proposal provide?

The school operates on a 2 form entry basis with two classes of up to 27 pupils in each year group. With the pupil numbers going down education is provided in mixed-age classes across Reception and Year I. This is likely to be needed for the foreseeable future in all year groups.

Cost

There are no significant costs but some small changes to classrooms will be required. These costs will be paid for by the school.

Option 2 is the preferred option. This will help manage staffing levels, budget and reduce surplus places with allowing room for growth. This option also releases space which can be used to provide nursery places.

Age range (nursery provision)

Option 2 is the preferred option. Establishing a nursery of 16 morning and 16 afternoon sessions will be manageable and limit impact on other nurseries in the local area. This option will offer benefits to offering early years places in an established school.

Impact of extending the age range and therefore creating a 16-place nursery class at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School

It is expected that the creation of 32 half-day placements at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School may encourage more parents in the local area to use the places created. This may then have an impact on the children who may go on to the Reception class as they have already attended the school and know the building and surroundings. If more parents do not use the places this could see the same number of children spread across several nursery classes/provisions, maybe resulting in other classes/provision reducing their morning/afternoon offers.

There is no impact on the Welsh-medium schools and the council's plans for growing the Welsh language through the 10 year Welsh in Education Strategic Plan (WESP).
