Joint School Reorganisation Proposal – Reduction in Capacity and Extension of Age Range at Malpas Church in Wales Primary School – Final Determination

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This school reorganisation proposal was being progressed jointly by the Council and the Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School in accordance with the statutory School Organisation Code and included a period of formal consultation followed by the publication of a statutory notice for the required period of at least 28 days.

The proposal passed through the statutory notice stage without objection. The Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School met and confirmed that it wished to implement the proposal. The Cabinet Member for Education and Early Years therefore take the final decision to implement the full proposal as consulted on.

Decision

The Cabinet Member for Education and Early Years approved the joint school reorganisation proposal progressed with the Governing Body of Malpas Church in Wales Primary School "to reduce the capacity of the school from 378 to 315 pupil places with effect from September 2024, and to extend the age range of the school from 4-11 years to 3-11 years with effect from September 2025".
