#### School Reorganisation Proposal – Increase in Capacity at Tredegar Park Primary School

#### **Options Considered/Reasons for Decision**

The formal consultation concluded on the school reorganisation proposal being progressed by the Council "to increase the capacity of Tredegar Park Primary School from 420 to 525 pupil places with effect from September 2024". The proposal launched in September 2023, with formal consultation running between 25<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and 12<sup>th</sup> November 2023.

A consultation report, described in detail the consultation process and the feedback received, was prepared and accompanied the report. It was also published on the Newport City Council website and shared with stakeholders. This decision report referenced the findings, the result of which recommended that the Council moved to publish a statutory proposal. Any legal objections lodged during the period of the statutory proposal would be considered in making the final determination.

#### Decision

The Cabinet Member for Education and Early Years took the Decision to move to publish a statutory notice for a period of 28 days in respect of the proposal to increase the capacity of Tredegar Park Primary School from 420 to 525 pupil places with effect from September 2024.
