Proposal to increase the capacity of Tredegar Park Primary School from 420 to 525 places with effect from September 2024.

The full statutory consultation process has now concluded on the proposal by Newport City Council to increase the capacity of Tredegar Park Primary School from 420 to 525 places with effect from September 2024.

Newport City Council's Cabinet Member for Education & Early Years considered all views expressed and responses received during the formal consultation process and decided to proceed with the proposal. Therefore, a Statutory Notice was published on 19th February 2024 for a period of 28 days and ended 17th March 2024.

No objections were received during the formal objection period therefore the final determination was taken by Newport City Council's Cabinet Member for Education & Early Years. I am pleased to confirm that the proposal will be implemented as consulted upon and detailed in the statutory notice, to increase the capacity of Tredegar Park Primary School from 420 to 525 places with effect from September 2024.
